 Copy of the New Jersey Business Registration Certificate for your company from the New Jersey Division of Revenue website.
 Company's license(s) (e.g., electrical business permit, electrical contractor license) applicable to the work your company will perform under the program.
 General liability certificate of insurance, employer's liability, and automobile insurance with a minimum of \$2,000,000 coverage per occurrence or \$1,000,000 liability insurance plus \$1,000,000 of excess umbrella.
 Workers' compensation certificate of insurance—\$1,000,000 required if your company has any employees.
 Three customer references. Provide customer's full name and address, their phone number, and a brief description of work done in

# Application process to become a participating electrical contractor.

After you've gathered the applicable documents, follow these steps to become a participating electrical contractor:

 Visit the <u>Join the Team page</u> and click the <u>APPLY NOW</u> button at the bottom to initiate the application.

As a participating electrical contractor, you will have the opportunity to:



- 2. When prompted, sign into your account.
  - If you have an existing account, please sign in using your existing username and password.
  - If you do not have an existing account, click **Create Account** to start your application.


3. After your account credentials are established, provide a point of contact and business details. Click **Continue** at the bottom of the page to proceed once complete.




4. When prompted, provide your business information. Click **Continue** at the bottom of the page to proceed once complete.



- 5. Select the **Participation Agreement** link to download and complete the PSE&G Participating Electrical Contractor Agreement. Upon completion, click **Continue** to proceed.
  - To avoid any interruption while completing your application, we recommend that users right-click the Participation Agreement link and open it in a new tab.
  - Please note that uploading a completed agreement is required for application submission.




6. When prompted, upload all of the required documentation. Once you have uploaded all documents, click **Complete Application** at the bottom of the page.



## What happens next?

Upon application submission, watch for the following message, which confirms your submission:



PSE&G's qualification vendor will then review your application for completion and accuracy. You'll receive an email if any additional information or documentation is required.

All approved contractors will receive a confirmation email with their application number. The application number is unique to your company. This number will be required to view and access all future customer applications.
